## **North Sanpete High School Baseball 2015 Disclosure Statement**

The goal of North Sanpete High School Baseball is to augment the academic opportunities of high school with an extra-curricular opportunity in order to prepare young men for the opportunities and challenges of life. Student athletes will learn: discipline, teamwork, respect for self and others, commitment to setting and achieving goals, sportsmanship, and an appreciation for hard work and fair play.

### **Player Participation Requirements:**

- Be in good academic standing, according to the rules established by UHSAA, North Sanpete High School, and the baseball coaching staff
- Be punctual for all team meetings, practices, games, and classes in school
- Attend ALL practices and meetings
- Be prepared and equipped to practice and play on time
- Accept responsibility to be physically and emotionally prepared to perform at the best of my abilities at practice and all games, and to avoid any activity, relationship, or action that may jeopardize that obligation
- Support and encourage all team mates in a positive manner
- Show respect to all coaching staff including the decisions that are made
- Obey all team rules including UHSSA rules for participation, including prohibition of using tobacco, illicit drugs, and alcohol
- Maintain and take responsibility for the team facilities and equipment. Student athletes are responsible for team uniforms and must return them by the designated date
- Take part in whatever fund raising activity the team decides to do
- Comply fully with the North Sanpete Athletic Department Grievance Process

Failure to comply with any of the requirements above may be considered Conduct Detrimental to the Team and may be grounds for dismissal.

Participation in activities that may endanger a player's health and/or show a disregard for obligations to the baseball team or team mates, may be considered Conduct Detrimental to the Team and may be grounds for dismissal. This may include but not be limited to participation in other sports (snowboarding, skiing, other recreational sports, etc.) and social activities that draws focus from obligations to the team or put the reputation of the team and North Sanpete High School in peril.

### **Participation Costs:**

Pay to Play (all players) \$75

\*\*\*Players with fee waivers will be required to help with work on the baseball field

Spirit Pack (all players) \$35

Includes: Hat, practice jersey (other items available for additional cost)

Kanab Tournament hotel (20 players invited) \$30

St. George Trip – hotel (20 players invited) \$30

Players will be responsible for their own equipment such as cleats, protective cup, practice pants, glove, red socks and red belt

Players are encouraged to use their own bats that comply with the UHSAA BBCOR requirements. The team does have several bats for use.

### **Physical Risk of Baseball**

As with any sport, there are risks involved in playing baseball. We train to limit those risks, but in order to ensure the best care of the athlete, it is imperative that athletes are forthright with their ailments. Coaches will work with athletes, parents, and medical professionals to make sure we act in the best interest of the athlete. Freshman are required to pass a physical examination before they are eligible (physicals taken for other sports will be accepted).

### **A Note to the Parents**

I am proud to be associated with your boys and to teach them this great game of baseball. I know you will work with me to ensure this year will be a positive experience. With that said, it is important to say that you and I will not always agree on game tactics and playing time. I would appreciate you contacting me with concerns before or after practice, but it is important that we are supportive of each other. Be positive, and make sure I display the same. We share the same goal, to provide a positive learning experience for the boys.
